

Iranian-Iraqi talks on situation in Syria, Gaza

Tehran, January 08 (QNA) – Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian and Iraqi Prime Minister Muhammad Shia' Al Sudani on Wednesday discussed the latest developments in Syria and the Gaza Strip, along with bilateral relations.
