

Natasha Baig and Adnan Dhool ignite the stage at QNCC's "Jadoon Punjab Bolda" - A night of music, culture, and unity

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Doha, Qatar: The Qatar National Convention Centre (QNCC) came alive last night with the soulful sounds of Pakistan as the much-anticipated concert “Jadoon Punjab Bolda” delivered an unforgettable evening of rhythm, melody, and cultural celebration. Together, Natasha and Adnan also paid homage to the icons of South Asian music, delivering stirring renditions of Ustad Nusrat Fateh Ali Khan’s qawwalis and a powerful cover of the Nooran Sisters’ classic.
