Amman, August 12 (QNA) – Jordanian Prime Minister Bisher Khasawneh has stressed that Jordan will never allow any entity, whatever it is, to use or infiltrate its airspace to imperil the security and safety of Jordanian people. This came during his meeting with a US congressional delegation who is on a visit to Amman.
