Brussels, October 15 (QNA) – Qatar's Ambassador to the European Union and NATO, HE Abdulaziz bin Ahmed Al Jehani Al Malki, highlighted the significance of the first-ever summit between Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) and European Union (EU) leaders, scheduled for Wednesday in Brussels.

He praised Qatar's global mediation efforts, highlighting its role in conflicts like the Russian-Ukrainian war, crises in Gaza and Lebanon, and humanitarian operations in Afghanistan. He reaffirmed Qatar's strong partnership with NATO, emphasizing its commitment to international peace and security.
