
Qatar Amir, Prime Minister of Italy hold official session of talks

Rome, October 21 (QNA)– HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani and HE Prime Minister of the friendly Italian Republic, Giorgia Meloni, held an official session of talks at Villa Doria Pamphili, in Rome, on Monday.

At the outset of the session, HE the Prime Minister of the Italian Republic, welcomed HH the Amir

and the accompanying delegation, hoping that the visit of HH the Amir would strengthen the relations between the two countries and promote them in wide-ranging fields.
