Doha, October 21 (QNA) – The competitions of the 4th Khalifa Open Squash Championship concluded. It was successfully held on the courts of the Khalifa International Complex with the participation of 60 male and female players in different age groups.

Secretary-General of the Qatar Tennis, Squash, Padel and Badminton Federation Tariq Zainal honored the winners of the first places in the championship during the closing ceremony of the

championship.

Player Walid Zaman won first place in the professional men's category, while player Youssef Faraj won second place.
