Doha, October 31 (QNA) – HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani revealed that he had discussed with HE Prime Minister of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, ways to strengthen bilateral coordination on the evolving situation in Gaza, the occupied Palestinian territories, and Lebanon, emphasizing efforts to support de-escalation in the Middle East.
