Trump declares victory, vows to "Make America Great Again

In a speech delivered early Wednesday, Donald Trump thanked the American people for electing him as the 47th president of the United States, marking his return to the nation's highest office after his first term from 2017 to 2021. "This is a magnificent victory for the American people,"
