Doha, December 11 (QNA) — The State of Qatar will reopen its embassy in the sisterly Arab Republic of Syria soon, after the necessary arrangements are completed, Adviser to the Prime Minister and Official Spokesperson of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Dr. Majid bin Mohammed Al Ansari, announced on Wednesday.

In a statement to Qatar News Agency (QNA), Dr. Al Ansari emphasized that this step aims to strengthen the close historical fraternal relations between the two countries and their peoples.
