

Türkiye to strengthen security beyond Southern borders starting in 2025: President Erdogan

President Recep Tayyip Erdogan announced that Türkiye will focus on ensuring security beyond its southern borders from 2025, particularly addressing terrorism threats. Speaking at the AK Party's 8th Ordinary Provincial Congress in Balikesir, Erdogan emphasized Türkiye's commitment to eliminating threats from neighboring regions.

Erdogan outlined his vision for Türkiye's future, stating that the country would work towards the
