Doha, December 31 (QNA) – The State of Qatar achieved remarkable progress in 2024, advancing steadily toward its long-term development goals under the Qatar National Vision 2030. Sustainability and innovation were also at the forefront, with Doha receiving the Shanghai Global Sustainable Development Award for its effective policies. Hamad International Airport was named “World’s Best Airport,” while Qatar Airways earned “Best Airline of the Year.”

Infrastructure projects under Ashghal garnered ten safety awards, underscoring Qatar’s focus on excellence and safety.
