

Qatar Amir, Iranian President hold session of official talks

Tehran, February 19 (QNA) – HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani and HE President of Iran Dr. Masoud Pezeshkian held official talks at the Republican Palace in Tehran on Wednesday, reaffirming their commitment to strengthening bilateral relations and addressing key regional and international developments.

HE President Pezeshkian welcomed HH the Amir and the accompanying Qatari delegation,

emphasizing the importance of enhancing cooperation for the mutual benefit of both nations. HH the Amir, in turn, expressed his appreciation for the warm reception, highlighting the deep-rooted Qatar-Iran ties and the need to advance collaboration in various sectors, including trade, energy, and investment.

The discussions focused on economic cooperation, boosting trade partnerships, and exploring investment opportunities in multiple fields. Both leaders also exchanged views on regional stability and pressing global issues of mutual concern, reaffirming their commitment to maintaining constructive dialogue.

The meeting was attended by HE Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al-Thani, HE Chief of the Amiri Diwan Abdullah bin Mohammed Al Khulaifi, HE Minister of Commerce and Industry Sheikh Faisal bin Thani bin Faisal Al-Thani, and other senior Qatari officials. On the Iranian side, HE Minister of Foreign Affairs Abbas Araghchi, HE Head of the Presidential Office Mohsen Haji-Mirzaei, HE Minister of Energy Abbas Aliabadi, and several high-ranking officials participated.
