


King Charles shows support for Canada amid tensions

These actions reinforce his support without directly challenging the UK's diplomatic relations with President Trump.

Carney later met with UK Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer, who praised the shared history and values between the two nations, emphasizing Canada's sovereignty.

While King Charles maintains a neutral stance on political issues, public sentiment in Canada varies, with some expressing dissatisfaction over the perceived lack of stronger support from the British monarchy. However, the King's gestures highlight his ongoing dedication to the Commonwealth and to Canada in particular.
