MIRPUR (AJK): April 22. Azad Jammu Kashmir President Barrister Chaudhry said that all available resources would be utilized to address Pakistan / AJK based Jammu Kashmir refugees' grievances on priority grounds.

President Sultan was talking to Azad Jammu Kashmir Minister for Transport Javed Butt who called on him at Jammu Kashmir House in the federal metropolis on Tuesday to apprise him of the problems being faced by Jammu Kashmir refugees residing in various parts of the country, it was officially said.
