Doha, April 24 (QNA) — The Joint Security Committee between the State of Qatar and the French Republic held a virtual meeting on Thursday, as part of the third edition of the Qatari-French Strategic Dialogue, with the aim of strengthening bilateral cooperation and exchanging expertise in the security field.
