rich tributes to the martyrs of Chicago who laid down their lives 139 years ago in 1886.

The speakers called for raising the salary package of the laborers, working class and demanded that the workers should be paid according to their hard work so that the children of the workers could also be benefited of health and education facilities being provided by the government.

Speakers accused landlords, capitalists and industrialists themselves of amassing wealth with both hands by avoiding to pay due wages to the workers, farmers and laborers according to their hard work, which, the speakers termed blatant abuse and injustice.

Speakers underlined that even by the current era in various parts of the world, the working classes were busy struggling like the workers of Chicago to secure their due rights. The working classes, they added, will achieve their rights through their unity and consensus.
