

Trump Nominates Waltz as UN Envoy

In a significant reshuffle of his foreign policy team, President Donald Trump has nominated Republican Congressman Mike Waltz as the next U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations. The appointment follows Waltz's resignation from his recent role as National Security Adviser, a position he held for less than a year.

Waltz, a former Green Beret and staunch Trump ally, is known for his assertive views on national

defense and a hawkish stance toward U.S. adversaries. His selection signals a continuation of Trump's hardline diplomatic posture, particularly in relation to China, Iran, and multilateral organizations that the former president has frequently criticized.

If confirmed by the Senate, Waltz will succeed Ambassador Linda Thomas-Greenfield, reinstating Trump's preferred leadership at the UN. With the GOP holding a Senate majority, confirmation hearings are expected to proceed swiftly.

Waltz's nomination underscores Trump's commitment to projecting U.S. strength abroad while keeping a firm grip on his diplomatic and national security agenda.
