China's yuan duly hit its highest in almost six months at 7.1980 per dollar. The euro edged up 0.3 percent to \$1.1333.

The dollar eased 0.4 percent to 144.21 yen, and away from Friday's top around 145.91.

The Aussie edged up to \$0.6466, having hit a five-month high.
