20 Palestinians martyred in Israeli airstrikes on Gaza

Gaza, May 05 (QNA) – Twenty Palestinian civilians were martyred early Monday after Israeli warplanes bombed large areas in the Gaza Strip.

The Palestinian news agency (WAFA) said, citing medical sources, that 15 martyrs and ten wounded were recovered after Israeli warplanes targeted several apartments in a building near the Karama Junction, northwest of Gaza City.

Four citizens were also martyred and five others were injured when Israeli warplanes bombed a home in Al-Sultan neighborhood, northwest of the Gaza Strip.

One citizen was martyred and several others were injured after an Israeli drone bombed a group of citizens east of Jabalia, north of the Gaza Strip.

Since Oct. 7, 2023, the Israeli occupation forces have launched an offensive on the Gaza Strip, resulting in the martyrdom of 52,535 civilians, the majority of whom were children and women, and the injury of 118,491 others.

This is a preliminary toll, with a number of victims still under the rubble and on the streets, unable to be reached by ambulance and rescue crews.
