Chinese President Xi Jinping stood alongside Russian President Vladimir Putin at Russia's Victory

Day parade in Moscow, symbolizing deepening ties between the two global powers. The event,

held annually to commemorate the Soviet Union's victory over Nazi Germany in World War II,

took on heightened significance this year amid rising tensions with Western nations.

Xi's presence marks a strong show of solidarity with Russia, reflecting Beijing's growing

partnership with Moscow despite global criticism of Russia's military actions in Ukraine. The Chinese leader was given a place of honor beside Putin during the military showcase, which featured a display of tanks, missiles, and thousands of troops parading through Red Square. Addressing the crowd, President Putin highlighted the importance of unity against what he described as "Western aggression," reiterating his stance on the conflict in Ukraine. He praised China's support, calling it a testament to the strength of their "strategic partnership." In a brief statement, Xi Jinping echoed sentiments of cooperation, emphasizing the need for stronger political and economic ties between the two nations.

The display of unity comes at a time when both Russia and China are facing mounting pressure from Western countries. For Beijing, the appearance alongside Moscow sends a clear message of defiance against Western sanctions and geopolitical pressure. Analysts view Xi's participation as a signal of China's willingness to support Russia diplomatically, if not militarily, amid its ongoing conflict with Ukraine.

The event concluded with a military flyover and a salute to veterans, solidifying what many observers see as a growing alliance that could reshape global power dynamics.
