

Zelenskyy awaits Putin in Turkey for critical peace talks

In a pivotal move towards ending the ongoing conflict in Ukraine, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy is preparing for potential peace talks with Russian President Vladimir Putin, set to take place in Turkey. The meeting, which is expected to serve as a significant diplomatic breakthrough, comes after months of escalating tensions between the two countries.

The Turkish government has offered to host the talks, marking its continued role as a mediator in

The outcome of this meeting could have significant implications for the future of the region, with the world watching closely to see if this will lead to a breakthrough or further escalate the conflict.
