Doha, May 14 (QNA) – HE Ambassador of the United States to Qatar, Timmy Davis, emphasized that the upcoming visit of HE President Donald Trump to Doha reaffirms the strength of bilateral relations and the deepening cooperation between the two nations. He praised Qatar's efforts in emerging sectors such as healthcare, information technology, and cybersecurity, marking them as key areas for future collaboration and innovation.

Touching upon joint mediation efforts, Davis commended Qatar's significant role in promoting peace and stability in Gaza, working alongside the US and Egypt to secure humanitarian aid and negotiate ceasefires. He acknowledged Qatar's active role in conflict mediation and its commitment to long-term peace solutions in the region.

Ambassador Davis also highlighted Qatar's status as a major non-NATO ally and its hosting of the largest US military presence in the Middle East, underscoring its importance as a strategic defense
