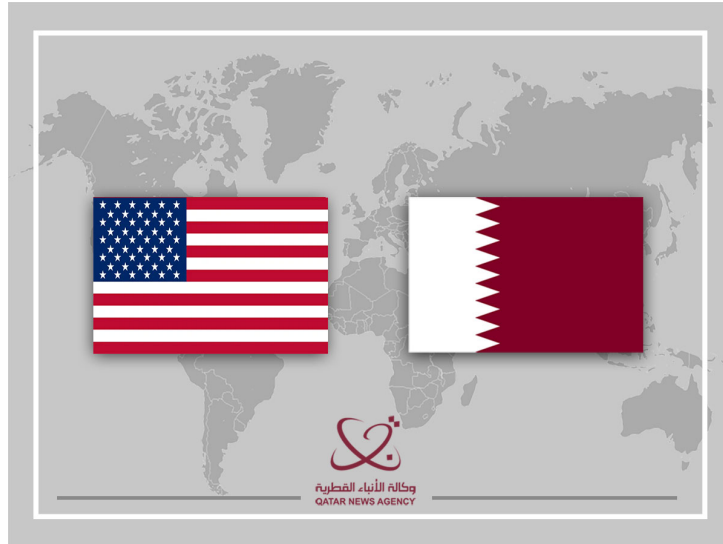

US President's visit promising prospects for Strengthening Qatar-US Partnership

The annual US-Qatar Strategic Dialogue serves as a platform to explore new avenues of collaboration, addressing key regional issues like the humanitarian crisis in Gaza, regional security, and economic development.

US Ambassador to Qatar, Timmy Davis, praised Qatar's role in mediating the Gaza ceasefire and its broader diplomatic efforts in regional stability. He described Qatar as a model partner for peace and conflict resolution in the Middle East, reflecting its contributions to global security and humanitarian relief efforts.

The two nations' strategic partnership has grown stronger over decades, marked by cooperation in politics, trade, education, and counter-terrorism. Since establishing diplomatic relations in 1972, Qatar and the United States have expanded their collaboration to include significant investments and energy projects, contributing to the stability of global energy supplies.

Qatar's efforts in Afghanistan, including facilitating US-Taliban negotiations and assisting in the

evacuation of American citizens, underscore its role as a trusted partner. US political circles continue to acknowledge Qatar's commitment to peacebuilding and regional stability.

Looking ahead, both nations aspire to enhance their partnership, focusing on mutual economic growth, regional security, and global stability. President Trump's visit signals a commitment to these goals, paving the way for deeper cooperation and stronger diplomatic ties.
