“My Azerbaijan” Concert Celebrates Independence Day in Qatar

On May 31, 2025, with the support and organization of the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the State of Qatar, a concert entitled “My Azerbaijan” by the music group led by singer Gunay Imamverdiyeva was held at the Doha University of Science and Technology on the occasion of the Independence Day of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

The concert was attended by members of the Azerbaijani community living in Qatar, heads and diplomats of the diplomatic corps of Turkey, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus in Doha with their families, a group of officers of the Turkish Armed Forces in Qatar and their families, influential media representatives, and students of the Doha University of Science and Technology.

Considering the presence of about 30 officers of the Turkish Embassy and the Turkish Armed Forces at the event, the singer specially performed the song "Çırpinırkı Kara Deniz."

It should be noted that more than 300 listeners participated in the concert, and the concert lasted for two hours.
