Ankara, June 24 (QNA) – Turkish president Recep Tayyip Erdogan underlined the need to establish a permanent ceasefire in the Gaza Strip as soon as possible, putting an end to the Israeli aggression, and ensuring that humanitarian aid reaches the Palestinian people without interruption.
