

State of Qatar renews firm commitment to UN Charter



New York, July 01 (QNA) – The State of Qatar renewed its firm commitment to the spirit and letter of the United Nations Charter, affirming its commitment to the UN continuing its role as a forum for dialogue and unity in the contemporary world.
