Tokyo, July 07 (QNA) – Japan's Minister for Foreign Affairs Iwaya Takeshi held a meeting on Monday with Secretary-General of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) Jasem Albudaiwi, who is currently visiting Japan.

interest, and updates on the progress of the free trade agreement between the GCC and Japan.
