MIRPUR (AJK): July 09: Rich tributes were paid to Madar-e-Millat (mother of the nation)Mohtarma Fatima Jinnah on her 58th death anniversary observed across Azad Jammu Kashmir on Wednesday with due solemnity and reverence.
