

China, Ghana celebrate 65 years with trade growth boost

ACCRA, July 9, 2025 – China and Ghana marked the 65th anniversary of their diplomatic relations with a significant milestone: bilateral trade between the two nations reached \$11.8 billion in 2024, reflecting a 7.1% increase over the previous year.

GHACHIFA Chairman Anani Demuyakor echoed these sentiments, pointing to the increasing interest in Mandarin language education in Ghanaian schools. "Language learning is helping bridge the communication gap and strengthening interpersonal ties," he said.

Demuyakor also pledged to intensify efforts to foster harmony and cultural appreciation between Ghanaians and Chinese residents in the country.
