BEIJING, July 10, Chinese President Xi Jinping has called for building a global network to foster dialogue and cooperation among civilizations. In a congratulatory letter to the Global Civilizations Dialogue Ministerial Meeting, which opened Thursday in Beijing, Xi emphasized China's commitment to promoting mutual understanding and peaceful coexistence worldwide.

Xi, also General Secretary of the Communist Party of China (CPC) Central Committee, said China is ready to work with all nations to implement the Global Civilization Initiative.
