MIRPUR (AJK): July 14: Describing July 13, 1931 as historic foundation day of the Kashmir freedom movement and a turning point of the Kashmiris just and principled struggle for securing right to self determination, Jammu Kashmir Liberation Front (JKLF) on Monday commended KGC for organising an international conference on Kashmir in Washington on the eve of anniversary of July 13 martyrs, organisers said in a statement released to the media here Monday.
