MIRPUR (AJK): July 19: While inaugurating Monsoon Tree Plantation drive at adjoining town of Islamgarhin Mirpur on Saturday, Commissioner Mirpur Division Chaudhry Mukhtar Hussain has said that planting trees was a charity, the main reason for the prevailing environmental changes was the cutting of trees and the lack of interest in planting new trees individually and collectively.
