MIRPUR (AJK): August 31 (: Paris-based Jammu & Kashmir Forum France on Sunday appealed to the international community to take strict notice of increased Indian atrocities, human rights violations, and illegal move to make demographic change in the population ratio in the Muslim-dominated Indian Illegally occupied Jammu & Kashmir state.
