DOHA, Qatar • 1 September 2025 – Qatar Energy and its partners were awarded an exploration license for the Nzombo offshore block in the Republic of Congo.

Under the terms of the Production Sharing Contract signed with the Congolese Government,

QatarEnergy will hold a 35% participating interest in the block. TotalEnergies affiliate in Congo

(the operator), will hold a 50% interest, while Société Nationale des Pétroles du Congo, the

Congolese national oil company, will hold the remaining 15%.

Commenting on the occasion, His Excellency Mr. Saad Sherida Al-Kaabi, the Minister of State for Energy Affairs, the President and CEO of QatarEnergy, said: "We are pleased to be awarded this promising offshore block in the Republic of Congo, and to work alongside our valued partners and the Congolese Government."

Located about 90 kilometers off the coast of Pointe-Noire, the Nzombo block covers an area of 1,053 square kilometers with water depths of more than 1,000 meters.
