MIRPUR (AJK): September 9: Special Assistant to the Prime Minister (SAPM) on Industries and

Production, Mr. Haroon Akhtar Khan, held a meeting with the President of the Mirpur Chamber of Commerce and Industry in his office in the federal metropolis on Tuesday.
