Multan, September 9, 2025 — MNS University of Agriculture Multan, in collaboration with the Pakistan Horticulture Development and Export Company (PHDEC) and the Export Development Fund (EDF), inaugurated a state-of-the-art dehydration plant facility to support the country's fruit and vegetable sector. Chairman National Seed and Development Authority, Prof. Dr. Asif Ali (Tamgha-e-Imtiaz), served as chief guest and highlighted the project as a major milestone for farmers, traders, and exporters, enabling value addition and improved export competitiveness.
