Meanwhile, the AIA Middle East Panel Discussion on *Women Shaping Sustainable Futures in Design*, moderated by Esra Lemmens, Founder & Design Strategist, The Esra Lemmens Agency, will highlight female leadership in sustainable design practices and their impact on regional projects, featuring insights from AIA Middle East Board of Director, VCUarts Qatar and ScaleQatar.
