Doha, November 2 (QNA)—HE Director of the International Organizations Department at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Sheikha Hanouf bint Abdulrahman Al-Thani, stated that the Second World Summit for Social Development (WSSD), to be held in Doha from November 4 to 6, seeks to renew global commitment to the principles adopted in Copenhagen and build upon past achievements to advance comprehensive and sustainable social development amid current

constructive role in global dialogue on justice and equality.
