Doha, November 05 (QNA) – HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani met Wednesday morning at the Amiri Diwan with HE President of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan Asif Ali Zardari, on the occasion of his visit to the country to participate in the Second World Summit for Social Development.
