Doha, November 10 – HH the Amir Sheikha Mozah bin Nasser bin Hamad Al-Thani and HE President of the Republic of Slovenia Natasa Pirc Musar held an official talks session at the Amiri Diwan on Monday, focusing on strengthening bilateral cooperation and expanding strategic partnerships across multiple sectors.

At the start of the meeting, HH the Amir welcomed the Slovenian President and her delegation,
