London, UK – November 11, 2025 (RKI) – World Summit AI Qatar, organized in partnership with the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology (MCIT), State of Qatar, is set to return to the Doha Exhibition & Convention Center (DECC) on December 9–10, 2025.
