QRI FC Thrissur emerged champions of the QIFF Super Cup 2025 after a thrilling and closely contested final against Grand Mall FC Malappuram, held at the Al Ahli Stadium over the weekend.

After five spot-kicks each failed to separate the teams, QRI FC Thrissur held their nerve in the decisive penalty, clinching the title and lifting the QIFF Super Cup 2025.
