MIRPUR (AJK): Dec. 23: In Indian Illegally occupied Jammu Kashmir state, the Indian occupational forces on Tuesday carried out anti-sabotage operations around key installations in Srinagar as

part of exceptional measures ahead of the Indian Republic Day falling on January 26, 2026, says, a report reaching here late Tuesday from across the line of control (LoC).

The operations were conducted in Maharaja Bazaar and Amira Kadal areas near Bakshi Stadium, the main venue for Indian Republic Day, likely to get the day celebrated by force in the disputed held Valley, the report revealed.

“The aim was to enhance, build up security arrangements afresh and prevent any much expected potential threats.

“Indian Security drills and preventive operations are conducted before Indian Republic Day to ensure that flag hoisting ceremonies, parades, and cultural events are not disrupted in the disputed occupied state,” the report said.

“The exercise involved the Indian police and the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) working in coordination to check and secure sensitive locations in the North Zone of Srinagar.

Areas have been cordoned off, and existing security arrangements have been intensified, the report said

“Similar extraordinary operations have also been carried out in parts of Anantnag district in the occupied valley “, according to the report

“Since the abrogation of Article 370 in 2019, public participation in forcibly managed Indian Republic Day event has decreased, with Freedom loving Kashmiris calls for boycotts largely of the New Delhi-sponsored Indian official ceremonies in the internationally-acknowledged disputed occupied Himalayan Jammu Kashmir state”, the report revealed.
