The funding plan will remain in effect while budget talks proceed in the coming weeks. Observers say the decision reflects a recognition of the need for cooperation amid wider economic and political challenges facing the United States.

The agreement underscores the Senate's intent to provide short-term stability while working toward a sustainable fiscal framework.
