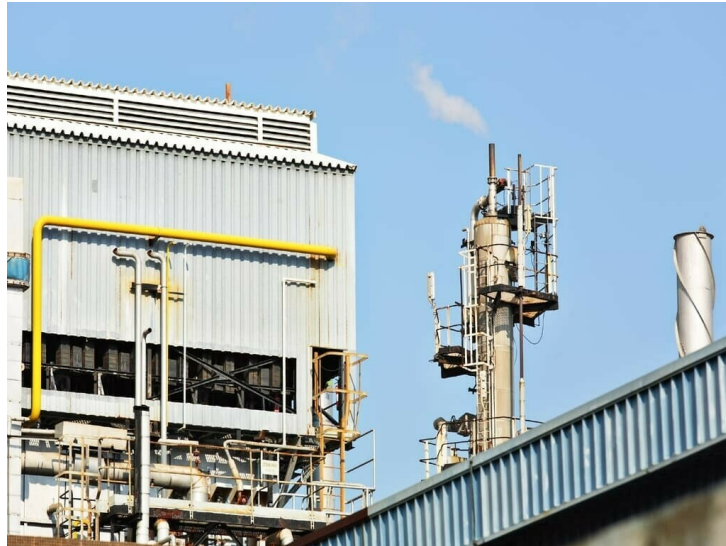


AJK govt evolves Integrated Industrial uplift plan to give impetus to promote trade & industrial activities in the State: AJK PM:

MIRPUR (AJK): January 11: Azad Jammu and Kashmir Prime Minister Faisal Mumtaz Rathore, has said that the government has evolved a comprehensive strategy to promote industry and trade across the liberated territory of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, it was officially said.
