Doha, January 18 (QNA) – HH the Amir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani held a session of official talks with HE Prime Minister of Canada Dr. Mark Carney at the Amiri Diwan on Sunday.

At the beginning of the talks, HH the Amir welcomed HE the Canadian Prime Minister and his accompanying delegation, wishing them a pleasant stay in Doha. His Highness expressed hope that the Prime Minister's state visit would contribute to expanding prospects for bilateral

cooperation in a manner that serves the interests of both friendly countries. HH the Amir also wished continued progress and prosperity for Qatari-Canadian relations.
