Dr.Amanulla Vadakkangara's 'Spoken Arabic Made Easy' released in Doha; Celebrated as a major step towards language learning and cultural integration

The book Spoken Arabic Made Easy by noted author, educator, and CEO of Media Plus, Doha, Dr. Amanulla Vadakkangara, was formally released in Doha over the weekend in a well-attended function organised in association with Radio Malayalam 98.6 FM.
