

New York City Schools Shift to Remote Learning Amid Heavy Snowstorm

NEW YORK, Jan. 25 — New York City public schools announced a citywide remote learning day as a major winter storm is expected to hit the region, with forecasts predicting up to a foot of snow across the city.

The Department of Education advised students, parents, and staff to stay safe at home and prepare

for online classes. All in-person activities, including extracurricular programs, have been temporarily suspended for the day to ensure the safety of students and staff.
