
QatarEnergy signs long-term helium sales and purchase agreement with Air Liquide



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DOHA, Qatar • 26 January 2026 – QatarEnergy and Air Liquide have signed a long-term sales and purchase agreement (SPA) for the supply of 300 million cubic feet per annum of helium from

Qatar.

The agreement marks a new milestone in the long-standing relationship between the two global energy and industrial gas leaders, with Air Liquide being a foundation customer, an important helium off-taker, and a key technology provider for a number of Qatar's Helium production facilities.

H.E. Minister Al-Kaabi added: "Qatar is one of the world's largest helium exporters. Our helium capacity is set to more than double with our North Field LNG expansion projects. This will further support a wide range of sectors and industries that depend on helium to drive human development."
