On responsible investment, Her Highness highlighted Qatar's transformation from an oil- and gas-based economy to a knowledge-based economy. She expressed confidence in Qatar's readiness to lead in technology, citing its strong investment in education and scientific research, transparent legal framework, ethical standards, and international credibility.

Concluding, Her Highness described participation in the summit as an invitation to invest in global research partnerships that direct technology toward serving humanity and shaping a responsible technological future.
